TAC Chairman Van Chesnut called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM.

Approval of Meeting Minutes:

Dick Jones moved to approve the minutes of February 12, 2013 as submitted. Mike Lavalla seconded and the motion passed unanimously. Dave Edkins and Barbara Brill abstained due to absence.

TAC Work Session- Prioritization of 2015-2024 Ten-Year Plan Projects

Nate Miller gave a presentation summarizing the work of the TAC Scoring Sub-Committee (Dick Jones, Clint Bean, and Richard Lee) in evaluating and recommending priorities for existing and proposed Ten-Year Plan projects.

There are a total of 28 existing and proposed non-programmatic Ten-Year Plan projects in the UVLSRPC Region totaling \$187 Million. If projects needed within urban compact areas are included, this figure climbs to over \$200 Million. The regional budget target for the 2015-2024 Ten-Year Plan is \$82 Million.

Nate Miller noted that four non-programmatic projects would be completed prior to the 2015-2024 Ten-Year Transportation Improvement Plan. It is assumed that these projects will not impact UVLSRPC's \$82 Million budget.
