# **EPA Brownfields Assessment Program**

The UVLSRPC was awarded \$300,000 on June 6, 2019, a three-year grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to continue the work originally identified in our initial brownfields award that will end on September 30, 2022. Unfortunately, we were not funded for the fiscal year 2023.

### **Hanover Stream Crossings**

The RPC will assist the Town of Hanover and conduct phase 1 of a 4-phase stream crossing assessment using the SADES State protocol.

#### **Headrest - CDBG**

#### **Household Hazardous Waste Collections**

The NH Department of Environmental Services assists with a small amount of funding; the remainder of the costs is billed to participating communities.

# **NHCF Sullivan County Trails**

The project is to create an county-wide trails plan for Sullivan County. Activities will include an inventory of the existing trail netorks in the county, conducting a needs assessment to identify opportunities, deficiencies, and gaps associated with the trail network, an implementation plan, and public engagement activities throughout the project to solicit public feedbac.

### **NHDOT Unified Planning Work Program**

Responsible Staff: All Staff

The RPC's transportation planning work has four categories: 1) Policy and Planning; 2) Public Involvement and Coordination; 3) Plan Support; and 4) Technical Assistance. In the Policy and Planning category, the Commission solicits and prioritizes projects for the state Ten-Year Transportation Improvement Plan (under RSA 228:99 and 240), contributes to the development of the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), and coordinates the development of the region's long-range transportation plan. In the Public Involvement and Coordination category, the Commission organizes the region's Transportation Advisory Committee, maintains the region's Public Involvement Plan, and conducts outreach to the general public about transportation issues/projects/programs affecting the region.

In the Plan Support category, the commission collects traffic data for all arterial and collector roadways in the region, coordinates the collection of data related to the receipts and expenditures of local governments on transportation (FHWA Form 536), and maintains transportation-related data for the region's Geographic Information System (GIS). In the Technical Assistance Category, the commission provides transportation-related technical

assistance to municipalities, and state agencies coordinate the development of special transportation studies (e.g., corridor studies), facilitates the region's public transit/human service transportation coordinating councils, provides technical assistance to public transportation providers, and reviews transportation-related impacts of large-scale development proposals.

## NH Office of Planning and Development (OPD) Targeted Block Grant

The RPC will continue to provide technical assistance to member communities on an as-needed basis, including but not limited to guidance on master plans, local regulations, grant assistance, and resource and data gathering. This will include limited aid with Geographical Information System data and management of that data. The Commission will work with its Planning Committee to respond to the growing number of Development of Regional Impact applications that we are receiving from communities within the region. The Commission will also continue to develop and distribute the monthly E-Bulletin for communities within the region.
